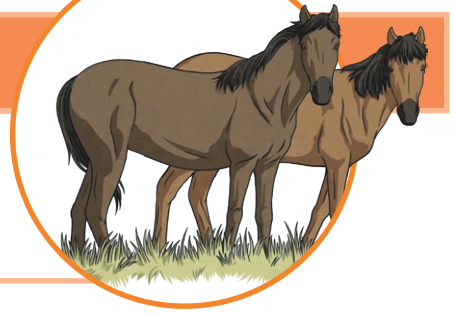




Singular and Plural in French

Key Information



Nouns are words that name things, people, places and ideas. Making a noun plural in French is quite straightforward. For most nouns, simply add **-s** to the end of the word.

Remember to make the determiners plural too:



le/la/l' (the)

les (the)

un/une (a/an)

des (some)

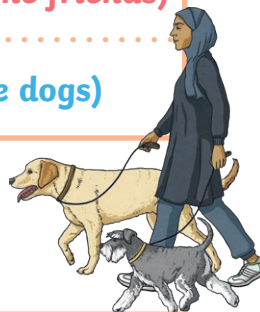

Singular and Plural in French

Irregular Plurals

Not all nouns follow the same pattern.

Nouns ending in -al

change to -aux in the plural

Nouns that end in -s, -x or -z

don't change in the plural

Nouns ending in -eu, -eau

add an -x in the plural

7 nouns ending in -ou (un bijou [jewel], un caillou [stone], un chou [cabbage], un genou [knee], un hibou [owl], un joujou [toy], un pou [head louse])

add an -x in the plural

Some plurals are completely irregular, e.g.

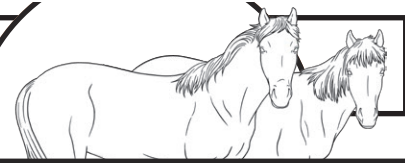
l'œil (the eye)
